- Collaborated with a cross-functional team to develop scalable, maintainable projects using PHP, JavaScript, MySQL, and Redis.
- Rebuilt a Symfony 4 application using Laravel 12 that ingests clinical trial data from multiple data sources. Created an AI pipeline to transform content for better readability. Provided a restful API so other applications can consume trials. Improved ingestion time from over an hour to 3 minutes by optimizing queries and utilizing concurrency
- Planned and built multiple WordPress plugins for a large multisite system with ~850 sites. Developed multiple Gutenberg plugins using PHP and React.
- Implemented ELK stack APM monitoring to help monitor our applications and curb costs
- Built an OpenAI/Elasticsearch integration to help content writers categorize stories, utilizing HTMX and PHP
- Planned and architected a full-featured calendar system for UF Health. Designed a survey for key stakeholders, did competitive analysis, and built the system using PHP and Svelte.
- Developed multiple components that ingest data from various third-party APIs and data sources
- Planned and implemented multiple React-based features that integrate with internal data sources
- Built multiple features for a Cake 2/Vue.js directory application used by ~40,000 UF Health employees
- Decreased our GitLab deployment process time by 80% by migrating to an atomic deployment system using PHP Deployer and Gitlab CI
- Performed code reviews and provided constructive, encouraging feedback.
- Managed and mentored a developer. Held 1:1's. Developed a plan of action for improving their development skills.
